#### Club Member Assistance

We are very fortunate that we have a number of players in our club who take on the role of director and manage our games efficiently.

We extend our thanks to Cheryl Dean, Lucia Mendonca, Vi Martin and Margaret Phippen for all they do for us.

There are a number of things we can do to help them carry out their duties:

- Arrive at least 15minutes before starting time
- Pass in boards when you are still bidding after the 3 minute warning beep has sounded
- EW should check the accuracy of the contract/score that NS has written
- Speak quietly after completion of your boards while others are still playing.

There are also actions that you can take that will help greatly with the packing up process.

- Avoid lengthy post-mortems at the end of the last hand—you are delaying those who stay to do the 'putting away' for you
- Shuffle cards quickly and take table cloths and bidding materials to the trolley ASAP
- Dispose of coffee cups and used bidding sheets before the start of the last round
- Bring your tables to the front of the room and stack them as soon as you can.

Thank you to all who arrive early to do the set up and those few who are always the last to go.
