## **General Reminder**

Please be aware of the impact that your behaviour at the tables may be having on other people.



When you finish your boards keep the noise level down while others complete their games. If you need to check a previous score wait until the relevant pair and/or the director has finished playing the current round.



Avoid lengthy or confronting discussions about hands. They can be very unpleasant for your partner and also for other members of the club. 'Post mortems' also take playing time away from your opponents.



Please turn your mobile phone to silent or vibrate. Loud ringing tones can distract other players. If you are expecting an important call or feel you may need to leave your phone on for a special reason you should advise the Director before the session starts.
